# JUBILEE PROCLAIMED

On Thursday past, the Holy Father Francis officially announced **2025 will be a Jubilee Holy Year.** The letter of proclamation, called a Bull, is titled *Hope Does Not Disappoint*. He said, "In the heart of each person, hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite our not knowing what the future will bring," and expressed his desire that the Jubilee might be "an opportunity for us to be renewed in hope."

The jubilee will open on Christmas Eve 2024 in Rome and close on 6 January 2026. More details to follow.

# THE HOLY SPIRIT AND HANDS



The Holy Spirit is God active and dynamic among us, doing. Wherever God the Holy Spirit is present, things happen today, and for this reason the Holy Spirit is, at times, thought of as God's hand, since human beings use our hands for much of our doing. So, in the gospels, we see how Jesus laid hands to heal the sick and bless the children, to bring about a tangible improvement in their lives. Jesus sent his apostles to do the same, and in the Acts of the Apostles, it is striking how God the Holy Spirit is given to believers by the apostles laying hands on them.

The Church keeps the rich sign of imposing hands to remind us of the all-powerful outpouring of God the Holy Spirit doing the grace of the sacraments:

- \* in Confirmation, bestowing his seven gifts
- \* in Eucharist over the bread and wine,
  "send down your Spirit upon them so that
  they may become...the Body and Blood of
  Christ"
- \* in Reconciliation, over the head of the penitent, effecting the forgiveness of sin
- \* in Anointing of the Sick, bestowing the healing of God as commanded by Jesus \* in Holy Orders, changing the man to be
- a priest for ever.

# CHURCH



The Bible tells us Mary was present at Pentecost, praying with the apostles for the coming of the Holy Spirit (Matt 1:14). She is present as Mother at the birth of the Church, and so Pope St Paul VI was prompted in 1964 to officially declare Mary, Mother of God to be also Mother of the Church.

Pope Francis instituted a day on the calendar every year to honour Mary in this role: as teacher of prayer, as model of what the Church should be, and as Mother personally to each of God's children: all of us, the baptised. Mary, Mother of the Church is celebrated on the Monday after Pentecost.
